I am pleased to announce the appointment of Jared Trumbo as a cross-cultural specialist with International Friendships, Inc. (IFI) in the role of Area Coordinator for the Triangle of North Carolina .

IFI is a nondenominational, evangelical, para-church missions organization that has been serving international students since 1979. It is based in Columbus, Ohio and has developed ministries throughout Ohio and other states. IFI works closely with local churches to fulfill its mission of serving international students. Our mission is to serve internationals and to partner with them to make Christ known among the nations.

IFI works with local churches to equip Christians to become cross-culturally sensitive friends to internationals by meeting basic needs such as airport pickup, temporary housing, furniture shopping, holiday hosting, and practicing English.

IFI also works directly with students on campus as we seek to develop leaders who will return home as effective witnesses for Christ. This often starts with giving non-Christian international the opportunity to learn more about Jesus through Bible discussion groups and continues with training Christian internationals in leadership.

Jared's role as local coordinator will be to oversee the establishment of a ministry to internationals at Universities in the Triangle portion of North Carolina including University of North Carolina, North Carolina State and Duke through the ways described above.

In the process of seeking God's will, it became clear to Jared and the IFI leadership that working with IFI is a natural extension of the type of ministry that Jared and his family have been doing for the past three years. Jared will be serving those who can make a significant contribution to the future of China including serving those in less privileged situations.

Jared is a clear answer to our prayers for someone to move into the area where IFI previously began a work. Jared has the ability and heart to build deep relationships with people. This quality is essential for ministry to internationals. Jared is a great teacher who is committed to sharing the gospel, experienced in cross-cultural relationships, and intensely focused on doing God's will and being sure that his time and energy are invested in eternal things. He has a godly family who is united in purpose to serve together. He is well prepared for this ministry and the calling to serve internationals is clear.

It is our hope that you will welcome Jared to share more of the ministry and the burden that God has placed on his heart. As a missionary with IFI, Jared is required to have a prayer and financial support team. In fact, Jared's first responsibility and privilege is to share the ministry with people like you. He is also seeking churches who will partner with him. Jared's budget is very modest. Jared will need funding to free him to be on campus and to mobilize and train local Christians in cross-cultural ministry. We hope you will prayerfully consider becoming a part of Jared's support team. He is worthy of your support.




# Dr. Obregon's Medical Trip to the Philippines

I just returned from a medical mission trip to the Philippines - T'boli in south Cotabato and northern Palawan Provincial Hospital in Taytay. There were 17 MMI members plus 10 local volunteers. We performed 249 surgical cases, 399 dental extractions, one oral surgery and 544 reading glasses were given out. One hundred ten people accepted the Lord as their Savior. The flannel board donated by the Disciple 4 study group was immensely helpful in the evangelistic part of the ministry. I witnessed the effectiveness of it since I observed their work for two days.
