



Does God Still Speak Today?

When we read the Bible we observe many examples of God speaking to men and women in a wide variety of ways. Does He still do that in our day and time? If so, how does God speak to us? Does God speak in an audible voice, through inner leadings or impressions, through dreams or visions, by making Scripture come alive to us, through the words of other people, in unusual circumstances?

Bill Hybels, in is book The Power of a Whisper writes, "...I've come to believe that hearing the quiet whisper of the transcendent God is one of the most extraordinary privileges in all of life — and potentially the most transforming dynamic in the Christian faith. When people hear from heaven, they are rarely the same again. When the sovereign God chooses to communicate with someone — whether eight, eighteen or eighty years old — that person's world is rocked." As we begin a new year together, let's think about how God speaks to us and how well we listen.





Life Skills Classes

Working with World Relief, we have developed a series of three threeweek classes for refugees and others who are interested in helping refugees and immigrants acclimate to our country. The classes will begin January 16 and focus on children and their development from babyhood through school age; nutrition and cooking with American foods—specifically adding fruits and vegetables to the diet; and finances with a focus on how to navigate banking, transportation and budgeting. The Nepali/Bhutanese neighborhood and Congolese/ Rwandan women are our primary focus, but anyone desiring information and help with adjustment to American life are welcome.
