

## The Passover Feast

Thursday, March 28, 2013 6:30 p.m.

In addition to Easter Sunday itself, the Passover Feast is our congregation's primary way of celebrating and observing the significance of Jesus' death and resurrection for us. We gather as a church family on the night Jesus gathered with His disciples to share the Passover Feast. This was the night that Jesus Himself introduced what we now refer to as Communion or the Lord's Supper. This was the night Jesus washed the feet of His disciples. This was the night before the cross and Jesus' sacrifice which made our salvation possible. Once again, Cory Baugher will be revealing how the Passover Feast, while actually a Jewish observance, reveals God's plan of salvation and points to the person and work of Jesus on our behalf. Your celebration of Easter will be enhanced by participation in this worship and fellowship event.

## Easter Sunday Baptisms

If you are a follower of Jesus, but have never been baptized, we encourage you to consider baptism on Easter Sunday, March 31 during our worship service.

### What's the significance of baptism?

- First, it's a biblical command we need to obey.
- Second, it's a public profession of your faith in Jesus and desire to follow Him.
- Third, it's an outward symbol of an inner spiritual reality. Going under the water symbolizes that you have died with Christ spiritually while coming up out of the water symbolizes that you have been raised to new spiritual life in Christ.

We ask individuals to come forward at the end of a worship service during the closing hymn or song as a public indication of their desire to be baptized.


