If You're Accused Of Being A Christian, What Evidence Will Convict You?

Imagine living in a country where it's illegal to be a follower of Jesus. If you were arrested and accused of being a Christian, could a court of law find enough evidence to convict you? Is your life different enough from those who don't follow Jesus that people can tell the difference? Would anyone say of you, "Oh, he's obviously a Christian" or "Well, of course, she's a follower of Jesus"? What kind of evidence would be brought against you in such a country?
