### Sunday, April 1

**What’s the significance of baptism?**

- First, it’s a biblical command we need to obey.
- Second, it’s a public profession of your faith in Jesus and desire to follow Him.
- Third, it’s an outward symbol of an inner spiritual reality. Going under the water symbolizes that you have died with Christ spiritually while coming up out of the water symbolizes that you have been raised to new spiritual life in Christ.
